WHO: Navy Seaman 1st Class Henry G. Tipton

WHAT: accounted for on February 5, 2018, will be buried with full military honors

WHEN: **Friday, June 8, 2018**

WHERE: in Ravenden, Arkansas

WHY: Tipton, 20, of Imboden, Arkansas, was killed during the attack on the USS Oklahoma in World War II. His return fulfills our duty to leave no fallen comrade behind. The 189th Airlift Wing will provide escort for Tipton on his final journey.
