SUBJECT: The Adjutant General's Policy 2023-10, Environmental Policy Statement

1. This memorandum supersedes The Adjutant General's Policy 2022-05, Environmental Policy Statement dated 27 January 2022.
2. The Arkansas National Guard is dedicated to preserving the environment while accomplishing our mission to provide trained and ready forces for state emergencies and to support our nation in the event of war.
