Receives comprehensive weather briefings and maintains thorough knowledge of atmospheric effects on lightweight aircraft due to the RPAs limited capabilities in crosswinds, updrafts, downdrafts, visible moisture and extreme heat or cold. Conducts flight testing, maintenance testing and Operational Test and Evaluation (OT&E) for existing and emerging RPA operating systems. Performs flight testing of the handling characteristics and performance of RPA to determine airworthiness. Evaluates RPA operational procedures and mechanical deficiencies and recommends new procedures or corrective actions. Compiles reports on the suitability, functionality and general practicability of the aircraft and components or systems. Conducts test and evaluation flights of the RPA following the installation of all modifications to the aircraft. Performs functional flight tests of RPA aircraft after addition of approved modifications. Develops, tests and validates new and established RPA tactics, techniques and procedures. Tests new munitions to ensure the RPA maintains a high level of airworthiness. Supports Large Force Exercises (LFE) and performs Continuation Training (CT). Maintains a thorough knowledge of aircraft systems and procedures under normal, instrument and emergency conditions. Maintains Combat Mission Ready (CMR) status as an RPA pilot. Serves as the Air Operations Officer's (AOO) representative when performing duties such as:

Operations Supervisor (OPSUP), Supervisor of Flying (SOF), or Mission Crew Commander (MCC); and is responsible for the safe and efficient mission accomplishment through the use of Operational Risk Management (ORM). Performs other duties as assigned.
