The Arkansas National Guard remains dedicated to providing all personnel with information regarding current service member focused financial assistance programs dedicated to mitigating financial hardships resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. **Mission.** The Arkansas National Guard immediately communicates current Soldier and Airman financial assistance programs to all levels of the organization in order to mitigate financial hardships suffered as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
