Arkansas DE&I (Diversity Equity and Inclusion) will change name to Career Pathways Program. NGB has not published new name yet. Names updated on Council Member and Working Group team.

B. TAG Executive Summary. The Arkansas National Guard (ARNG) Diversity and Inclusion Strategic Plan outlines the implementation of the President's Executive Order 13583 on the establishment of a coordinated government-wide initiative to promote diversity and inclusion in the federal workforce. It aligns with the National Guard Bureau (NGB) Diversity and Inclusion Strategic Plan. The Arkansas National Guard Diversity and Inclusion Strategic Plan is a roadmap to help leverage diversity to improve mission accomplishment. Properly managed diversity in an inclusive environment acts as a combat multiplier. Leadership involvement is essential to the success of the program.

Branch Diversity: Increase in minority/ethic and female presence/numbers in the following branches: Aviators, Physicians/Dentists & JAGs. 25% increase of women in Combat MOS' and senior leadership positions. Possible changes to occur with new TAG selection.
