
## HOW TO SPOT AN OFFICIAL SOCIAL MEDIA SOURCE

One way to tell a social media page is official is the check mark. Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram use check marks as a way to show you that the account has been verified and is the official page of a valid person/business/organization.

Another way you can tell a social media page is official is by this wording on the page: Official Twitter account of the Arkansas National Guard. (Following and/or Listing does not = endorsement.)
